2025 SCHSBC Alumni Bowling Tournament Rules**1 Rules**

- a. The Tournament Committee will be composed of the tournament director and Stark County High School Bowling Conference (SCHSBC) representative(s).
- b. The Rules Committee will be composed of the tournament director and non-participating SCHSBC representative(s).
- c. Any issues or disputes will be decided by the Rules Committee based on USBC rules or OHSA regulations.
- d. All rulings will be made by the Rules Committee will be final.
- e. Tie Breakers will be a one shot roll off using 1 on lane 14, bowling before seeding is finalized using a coin flip to determine who bowls first on the same lane. Goes until a winner is determined.

2 Prizes & Awards

- a. The entry fee, prize money and payouts shall be set by the Tournament Committee with profits benefitting the SCHSBC.
- b. Ball Raffles will be held (with winners needing to be present) - bowling ball was preselected before the event.

3 Team Composition

- a. Teams shall have a minimum of five (5) bowlers, with a maximum of six.
- b. Teams with less than five (5) bowlers may only bowl the 10th frame up to 6 times during qualifiers and 3 times during head to head.
- c. Teams may be comprised of any gender as long as they are not current students in high school.
- d. Each team member must have attended, graduated, pay taxes in, or don't have a team to bowl with and/or served as the boys or girls coach of the designated school. Director may allow outside bowlers on a team if tournament does not hit the projected number of teams.
- e. The line-up (order) may be changed from game to game, but not within a game.
- f. Substitution of bowlers not in the line-up may be made at any time, but bowlers removed may not return until the next game.
- g. 5 bowler teams may not sub during a game, but may change line up every new game.

4 Competition

- a. A 12 game elimination format with a maximum of 30 teams will be used.
- b. The lanes will be filled by blind draw the night before the tournament.
- c. The first round will be a best-of-five games, with all subsequent rounds best-of-five.
- d. Lane assignments for all rounds will be pre-determined by the Tournament Committee.
- e. No round will be started until the tournament director signals.
- f. 1 ball warm up per bowler on each lane. Higher seed chooses starting lane.
- g. Left lane starts the match, keeping pace with frames. 1 lane courtesy.

5 Head to Head Format

- a. The Baker scoring format in which bowlers bowl two frames (e.g., 1st & 6th, 2nd & 7th, ... 5th & 10th) will be used for all portions of the competition.
- b. No handicaps will be used.
- c. Any tied games must be broken before proceeding to the next game.
- d. Game ending in ties will be broken by a bowler designated by the team captain bowling a higher score in the 9th & 10th frame on the same lane as the game bowled.
- e. The scores shall be recorded on the provided form, attested and submitted to the tournament office once the round is completed.
- f. Team with the higher pin fall after 4 games chooses lane for the 5th game.
