Stark County High School Hall of Fame Guidelines for Nomination and Election

Purpose:

The purpose of the Stark County High School Bowling Hall of Fame is to recognize and honor those Stark County High School Bowling Conference athletes, coaches, administrators and supporters who excelled in high school bowling or coaching/support roles and who helped to bring honor, recognition, distinction and excellence to the Stark County High School Bowling Conference by their conduct both on and off the lanes of competition. This recognition will help maintain the spirit, pride and sense of community as well as serving as a historical account of the great bowling traditions of Stark County High School Bowling.

Details:

A hall of fame will be constructed on the Stark County High School Bowling website. All athletes selected to receive this honor will have their biography and awards received in a special page along with their name, graduation date, average, list of accomplishments and school on the site of their overall career.

Eligibility for Nomination:

Athletes are eligible for nomination 10 years after their class's graduation. They must be in good standing or in special circumstances as determined by the Board Members. Such athletes must have competed in 3 years of SCHSBC competitions and must have been on 1st Team all conference at least one year. Among the accomplishments taken into account will be individual (all-conference, all-district, all-state) and team accomplishments, (District Qualifiers, (Regional Qualifiers) and State Qualifiers). Individual school or team records held, and impact on teams and the overall SCHSBC during their era and accomplishments thereafter.

Nomination is also open to coaches or administrators, who must have participated with distinction and/or made significant contributions to the SCHSBC, as evidenced, for example, by the success of their teams and the acknowledgment of their former student-athletes. Such coaches or administrators shall be eligible for nomination beginning five years after they have left the SCHSBC for any reason, or in special circumstances as determined by the Board Members.

As determined by the Board Members, Contributors will also be considered for nomination based upon their service and dedication to the SCHSBC..

Nomination Process:

A candidate may be nominated for Hall of Fame membership by any member of the community. Formal nomination shall be made using the nomination form prescribed for such purpose and made available to the public. The nomination form must be received by the SCHSBC by **January** 1st of voting year. Application packets will be on the SCHSBC website. www.starkcountyhsbowling.com

All applications are to remain confidential, to be shared among the members of the Board only. Information relating to a nominee's career statistics, records, achievements, etc. must be supported by accompanying documentation or sources cited so that the information may be verified independently.

All application packets from the nominee must be received by the SCHSBC by **January** 1st of the nominating year, in order to be considered for induction into the March banquet. Both the nomination form and the application packet will be available through the web site. Once presented as an eligible nominee, a candidate who is not elected shall automatically be reconsidered annually until he/she has been considered for five years. Thereafter, re-nomination may occur at any time. The Commissioner will notify any nominators if their nominee was not selected.



Stark County High School Hall of Fame Guidelines for Nomination and Election

Board Members:

- The Board Members may be comprised of people from the following list:
- SCHSBC Commissioner (who organizes and presents nominee to board members)
 - The SCHSBC President, who shall serve as a standing Board Member and may appoint their own Chairperson.
 - SCHSBC Vice-President
 - Retired or former SCHSBC Administrators or Coaches
 - Current SCHSBC Coaches (Male or Female Teams)
 - Local Business Owners/Community Leaders
 - All Members shall be appointed by SCHSBC Administrators, and shall serve for a two year term initially.
 - There shall not be fewer than 3 members at a time.

Election Process:

The Board Members shall meet at a time determined by the SCHSBC Commissioner in order to nominate, review, and elect candidates. The quorum for any meeting at which election of candidates shall take place shall be a majority of members. Background information on each nominee should be distributed to Board Members prior to the meeting and members should familiarize themselves with the nominees prior to voting. Each Board Member shall have one vote and all votes shall carry equal weight. In order to gain election, a candidate is required to receive a number of votes equal to 75% of those members present at the

meeting. Candidates shall be discussed in alphabetical or chronological order as designated by the Commissioner. The outcome of the verbal vote will be shared with the Board Members only. If, in the opinion of the Board Members (as evidenced by failure to obtain the 75% threshold described above), no candidate nominated in a particular year is worthy of election to the Hall, so be it; it is not necessary to induct new members each year. At the same time, there shall be a limit of the number of three members who may gain admission in a given year. The two members may be any combination of female bowlers, male bowlers, coach or administrator.

Induction Ceremony:

The induction ceremony shall be at annual Stark County High School Bowling Conference bowling banquet held and the end of the season, usually in March. The induction ceremony will be during the annual banquet for the SCHSBC bowlers and coaches and the inductees and their families and which shall be open to the public. The conference may pay for the bowlers meal only and will require any guests to pay the going rate for each meal, based on the financial status each year.

Hall of Fame inductees shall wear formal attire at the banquet when being inducted. We will take pictures after the banquet for online purposes. Inductees will receive a hall of fame plaque during the banquet festivities sponsored by a local business to be determined each season.

Criteria: 3 years in conference, at least 1 year on 1st team all conference. Bowlers must wait 10 years from their graduation class date to be eligible. Exception: Any bowler that is 1st team all conference all 4 years as a conference member may be eligible immediately after highschool unless it affects their collegiate status, to which point they will have to wait until they graduate college. It is athletes responsibility to confirm this before accepting the award.
